Well, if Lady Anne Montgomery is my favourite, I shouldn't say this but The Golden Keyboard is my least. This perhaps is a hand-me-down from my days of harmonica playing (just try it on a D harmonica and feel your lungs collapse!); but it isn't the handiest tune on concertina, either. Some fellow-concertina-ists agree with me; others don't. Maybe you'll love it! Not that difficult, perhaps; but you do have to watch for unexpected row changes! Practice....

In general, just change A6 to A7, and where an E' follows, change that from C7 to G5.
